LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY PROCLAMATION

No. 2020.1 – March 18, 2020

A State of Emergency is hereby declared in the Village of Kings Point beginning at 5:00 pm. on March 18, 2020, and ending at midnight on April 30, 2020.

The State of Emergency has been declared due to emergency conditions produced by the coronavirus pandemic that is impacting the well-being of millions of people, with more than 6,280 cases reported in the United States, and a death toll of more than 100 people, more than 900 cases in New York City, more than 131 Cases in Nassau County, and a significant number of people who have tested positive on the Great Neck peninsula.

Such conditions threaten or imperil the public safety of the citizens of this Village.

Accordingly, I hereby order that all persons within the Village of Kings Point cease and desist from assembling at and/or otherwise utilizing places of public assembly (including, but not limited to places of worship) within the Village of Kings Point, and that all pedestrian and vehicular movement in support of the assembly at and/or usage of such places and the parking and standing of vehicles at such places, by other than the staff thereof at such places, is prohibited; except that this Order shall not affect providers of essential services such as fire and police, when those services are being provided.

Pursuant to New York State Executive Law, Article 2-B, any person who knowingly violates this order is guilty of a Class B Misdemeanor.

As Chief Executive of the Village of Kings Point, I have exercised the authority given to me under said Article 2-B, to preserve the public safety and hereby render all required and available assistance vital to the security, well-being and health of the citizens of the Village of Kings Point.


I hereby direct the Police Department of the Village of Kings Point to enforce this order and to take whatever steps necessary to protect life and property, public infrastructure and other such emergency assistance as deemed necessary.

The residents of the Village should follow the recommendations of the coronavirus task force, the Center for Disease Control, the World Health Organization, and other health professionals to, among other things, maintain social distances of 6 feet and, when feasible, to shelter in place and limit your home to your immediate family. Remember, the failure to follow those recommendations puts not only you but your parents, spouse, children, friends, and the entire community at high risk.

The Village of Kings Point Police are equipped to respond to certain health emergencies. The Village police cars have oxygen and epi pens; but not coronavirus test kits. In a real emergency please call the police desk at 516.482.1000.
